A Message from Alice ...

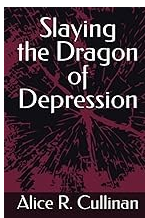
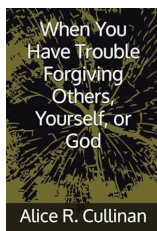
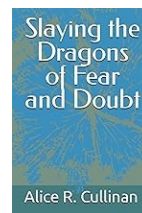
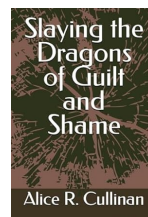
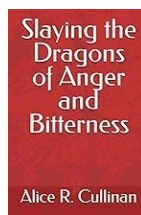
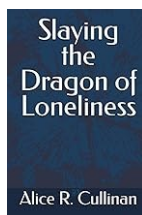
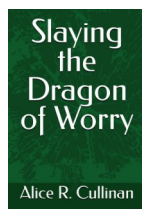
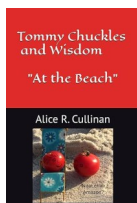
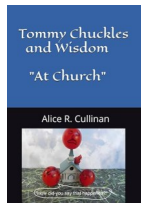
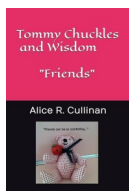
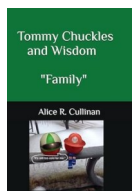

You can encourage your church or class to witness this way. Pastors might want to keep the mini-books on hand to give out to people they counsel. We want to hear from you soon!

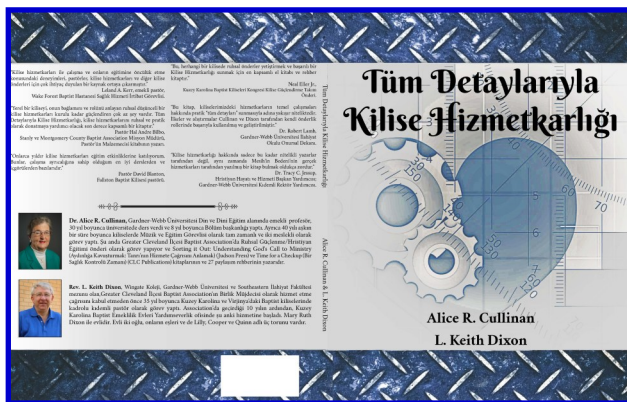
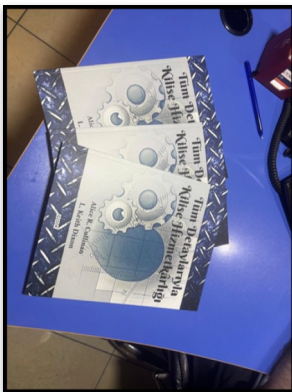
